

Poster submission guidelines

- The digital version of a poster should be submitted in PPT (2-4 slides with the additional introductory slide) by **Thursday, 20th July** using [THIS LINK](#) ;
 - The introductory slide should include full name, contact email, and institution;
- An abstract, elaborating on poster's content, should be submitted alongside. **Abstract requirements are as follows:**
 - The abstract should be submitted as a separate PDF that should have the same file name as the poster title;
 - The abstract **should be** relevant to life sciences and **should not be** promotional;
 - The length of abstract should be **200-250 words** (+/- 10%);
 - It is advised to avoid using references in the abstract. The abstract should be focused on the original research instead of the work of others;
 - The abstract should be revised before submission as it will be put up for evaluation as received;

- Posters and abstracts will be evaluated by „Life Sciences Baltics“ content committee. It will select **9 winning posters** whose owners will be invited to present their work in-person during „Life Sciences Baltics“ event in Vilnius, Lithuania on **20th September**;
 - The presentation using PPT will be limited to **6 minutes** with **2 additional minutes** dedicated for Q&A;
 - Owners of winning posters will receive a full two-day admission to the „Life Sciences Baltics“ event;
- Owners of qualified posters will be announced on **Wednesday, 6th September** on the event's website and on [LinkedIn](#). Additionally, they will be notified individually by email;
 - Upon announcement, a complete evaluation table with points scored will be published;
